Position: Alternative Break Site Leader (ABSL)

Description:

An Alternative Break Site Leader (ABSL) is a current student who plays a critical role in the planning, preparation and execution of an Alternative Break trip. Each leader serves as a liaison between the Campus Ministry staff and their team (trip attendees). They are responsible for assisting in the recruitment of alternative breakers, participating in all fundraising efforts, facilitating reflections, and coordinating informational meetings with their team. The ABSL meets frequently with Campus Ministry staff and other Alternative Break site leaders to receive direction and support throughout the academic year. There is a time commitment of at least one hour a week.

Benefits:

ABSLs are at the forefront of an exciting and meaningful service experience. They truly have the opportunity to develop their organization, communication and leadership skills. ABSLs get the chance to build meaningful memories and relationships through the experience. Moreover, the ABSL is required to fundraise for their trip expenses, but if their fundraising goal is not met, they are not required to pay the remaining balance. All breakers receive a T-shirt and gift before their departure.

Requirements:

- Complete and submit the attached AOL Application by February 10th.
- Participate AOL Mega-Selection Interview Day on Sunday, February 26th from 8am-5pm.
- Participate in all AOL Mega-Training on Friday, April 7th – Sunday, April 9th (more details will come soon, but please reserve that weekend to be on campus).
- Must have participated in an Alternative Break trip in the past.
- Must feel comfortable leading other students in spiritual conversation and reflection.
