Position: Tour Guide

Description: Tour Guides provide perspective families and students with an interactive look at the campus. Tour guides walk families and students around campus while sharing important information about Alvernia and their own personal stories from their time spent here. Tour Guides must be knowledgeable about the different buildings on campus as well as some of the history of Alvernia. Tour Guides also answer any questions the families and students may have about Alvernia. Tour Guides must be friendly and be able and comfortable talking with people they do not know.
